As a mentor, you will be asked to share your faith story with your students. Each of the questions below is designed to help you think through different aspects of your story. Please pray before you begin, and take your time answering each question.

What events led to your personal relationship with Jesus? How did those events shape your understanding of Jesus and what it means to be a Christian?
2. Think about the people who have mentored you or helped you grow in your relationship with Christ. How did they help you, and what impact did they have on your life?
3. Share a Bible verse or Bible story that has had a significant impact on your life. How has it impacted you?
4. What inspired your interest in becoming a mentor through Crossroads? Why do you feel called to serve men and women in prison?
5. Read Luke 4:16–19 and Matthew 25:31–40. What things did Jesus say were central to His ministry? How might these things relate to the work you will be doing as a mentor through Crossroads?

Respond to Sample Student Questions

Some Crossroads students are not Christians or are very new to Christianity. Some may be reading the Bible for the very first time. Other students have studied the Bible for their entire lives and are taking the courses to deepen their theological knowledge and to connect with you, a brother or sister in Christ on the outside. Please keep in mind that many students do not have access to biblical study resources. You may be the only person who can help them find answers to their questions.

Below are examples of student questions you may encounter. **Please read the questions and write responses to both.**Respond as though you are writing to someone who is a new Christian or someone who has not yet decided to follow Jesus.

Student question #1:

I am not sure how salvation works. I've been told by different people that I need to belong to a specific denomination or that I need to perform certain duties, which I may not have a way of doing in my facility. I am confused, but I really want to be saved. Can you help me understand what I need to do to be saved?
